PHS Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes

March 25, 2014 Approved, 4/22/2014

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on March 25, 2014, at the Fairport Historical Museum

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Robert Hunt.

Secretary's Report and Minutes. Doug Whitney

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on February 25, 2014, were approved as submitted with the following corrections:

Minutes, page 3, Director, Past Events. Change second sentence to read; : "Jean Whitney on house research, Suzanne Scheirer on genealogy, and Bill Keeler on Past Perfect."

Minutes, page 3, Director, Face Book. Change 160 "likes" to 115 "likes".

Treasurer's Report. Linda Wiener

Treasurer Linda Wiener submitted her written report for fiscal year from September 1, 2013 through February 29, 2014, as follows: (1) balance sheet shows total assets and equity of \$114,868 (up \$3,432 from 1/31//13, and up \$6,122 from FYE 2013; (2) profit and loss for 09/1/2013 – 2/29/14 is a net gain of \$7,024; (3) total year to date income compared to budget total income projected for year was \$14,012 v. \$16,490 for the year or 85% of budget for the year. (4) total year to date expense compared to budget total expense projected for year was \$8,988 v. \$16,396, or 45% of budget for the year.

Notes:

Income higher Sept. through Dec 2013 than PY due to change in reporting method-2013 dues are now reported in 2013.

Scholarship Fund balance is \$1,925.18 as of 2/28/14.

Goals for 2013-14 are as follows:

Set up online sales tax filing.

Work with Bill Keeler to determine cost of goods for gift shop by FYE

2014.

Work with Museum Director to obtain grant funding. Establish as a minimum quarterly meetings of the Finance Committee. Encourage use of tax exempt certificates for general purchases. Treasurer's report was accepted and approved as submitted.

Wants a line item expense reservation of \$50 - \$75 per month for 2014-15 budget. Treasurer Linda Wiener advised that this is already in the 2013-14 budget.

If FHM is to be wireless, need wireless routers and wireless adapters. Estimated total cost \$380.
