



# FAIRPORT MUSEUM

Listed on the National Register of Historic places, our landmark building was constructed in 1937 as the Fairport Public Library. Built in the Georgian Revival style, the interior highlights an 18-foot mural painted by local artist Carl W. Peters. The Library eventually outgrew the space and moved to the Village Landing in 1978. The building then became home to the Fairport Historical Museum.

The Museum is operated and maintained by the Perinton Historical Society, a nonprofit volunteer organization. It operates using the American Alliance of Museum's standards and enhances the collections by acquiring items associated with Perinton and Fairport during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.



Stop by and soak up some local history by exploring our exhibits on the **ERIE CANAL, FAMILY, FARMING & INDUSTRY EXHIBITS.** The South Wing exhibits showcase domestic and family life, education and social organizations. In the North Wing, you can see historical displays on farming, the Erie Canal, local business and inventors.



**DIG UP SOME RELATIVES.** Looking for your ancestral roots? Our collections are extensive and include many resources for genealogical study, cemetery records, residential directories and biographies of early settlers. We also have information on local architecture and structures.

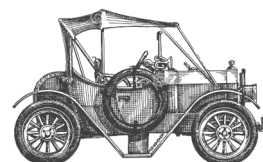
